There are few long-pending issues that need to be discussed by a dedicated Study Group of CCAs who are required to discuss/deliberate among themselves and come with a presentation to be made in the slots indicated in the agenda, which will follow. The recommendation of the Study Group shall thereafter be examined by the Board for a meaningful resolution.

3. The details of four Study Groups and designated topics for discussions are enclosed as **Annexure-I.**

4. Finally, the CCAs are requested to come prepared with the following information in respect of their Zones-

- (i) Status of implementation of reservation in promotion-whether "Own Merit" being given or not.
- (ii) Preparation of rosters of different cadres.

- (iii) Status of promotion from Gr B Non- Gazetted to Gr B Gazetted- number of existing vacancies in different Grades
- (iv) Implementation of Pankaj Nayan judgment and ZOC determination- whether mock exercise done or not
- (v) Seniority lists of Inspectors, whether as per N. R. Parmar? If yes, date of application of Parmar judgment
- (vi) Data on M. Subramaniam cases, no. of cases implemented so far, revenue implications thereof, no. of officers who are likely to get the benefit from in-rem implementation of M. Subramaniam case and financial implications thereof
- (vii) Current status of e-PPOs
- (viii) Data on Officers likely to benefit from DoP&T OM dated 12.08.2021 (3 months relaxation in eligibility service)
- (ix) Data on Officers likely to benefit from OTR for promotion to the post of EA (residency period in TA cadre reduced to 6 years, as on 28.09.2015, as a one-time measure)
- (x) Any other information relevant for the discussion as per the enclosed agenda.

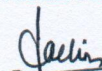
