G.S.R. No. 662..... In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the constitution and in supersession of the Marine establishment (Customs and Central Excise Departments) (Group 'C' and 'D' posts) Recruitment Rules, 1986 and the Customs Marine Division (Group 'C' and Group 'D' Technical posts) Recruitment Rules 1986 (excluding the posts of Seaman Gr.II and Driver) in so far as they relate to the posts Skippermate, Foreman of Stores, Engineer-mate, Artisan, Senior Storekeeper, Senior Draftman, Tindal, Engine Driver, Draftman, Storekeeper, Launch Mechanic, Sukhani, Senior Deck Hand, Asstt. Storekeeper, Trademan, Seaman, Greaser, Lascar, Unskilled Industrial Worker (UIW) except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to Group 'C' and 'D' posts in the Marine Organisation of Customs and Central Excise Department.

1. Short title and commencement.

These rules may be called the Marine Organisation of Customs and Central Excise department (Group 'C' and 'D' posts) Recruitment Rules, 1994.

They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the official Gazette.

2. Application : These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column 1 of the Scheduled annexed to these rules.

3. Number of posts, classification and scale of pay : The number of the said posts, their classification and the scales of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in Columns 3 to 5 of the said schedule.

4. Method of Recruitment age limit other qualification etc. The method of recruitment age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns 6 to 15 of the said schedule,

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5. Initial constitution : The incumbants of the posts shown in the schedule who were recruited/appointed on a regular basis before the commencement of these rules shall be deemed to have been appointed under these rules. The service rendered by them in a post on regular basis shall be taken into account for, deciding the eligibility for promotion to the next higher post.

6. Disqualification : No person, -

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living or
- (b) who, having a spouse living has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to any of the said posts.

provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, may exempt a person from the operation of this rules.

7. Power to relax :

Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

8. Saving :

Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Ex-Serviceman and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

THE SCHEDULE

G.S.R. 334.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Group 'C' and 'D' posts of Marine Organisation of Customs and Central Excise Department Recruitment Rules, 1994.

1. (1) These rules may be called the Marine Organisation of Customs and Central Excise Department Group 'C' and 'D' posts Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 1997.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Schedule to the Marine Organisation of Customs and Central Excise Department Groups 'C' and 'D' posts Recruitment Rules, 1994 against serial number 1 relating to the post of Skippermate;

(a) Under Column 10, for the Note, the following Note shall be substituted, namely:—

Note:—“Tindal/Sukhani/Senior Deckhand/Seamen having qualified Departmental Promotion Committee interview may be exempted from 9(a)(i) and (ii)”.

(b) Under Column 13, for the words “Promotion from the grade of Tindal with minimum 5 years service i.e. in the grade” the following shall be substituted, namely:—

“Promotion from amongst Tindal/Boats with 5 years service or Sukhani with 10 years service or Senior Deckhand with 12 years service or Seaman with 16 years service; Provided that Officials in lower grade will be considered only if eligible officials in higher grades are not available;

Provided further that if an official does not have sufficient number of years of service in that grade, his/her services in the lower grade/s, if any will be taken into account.”
