

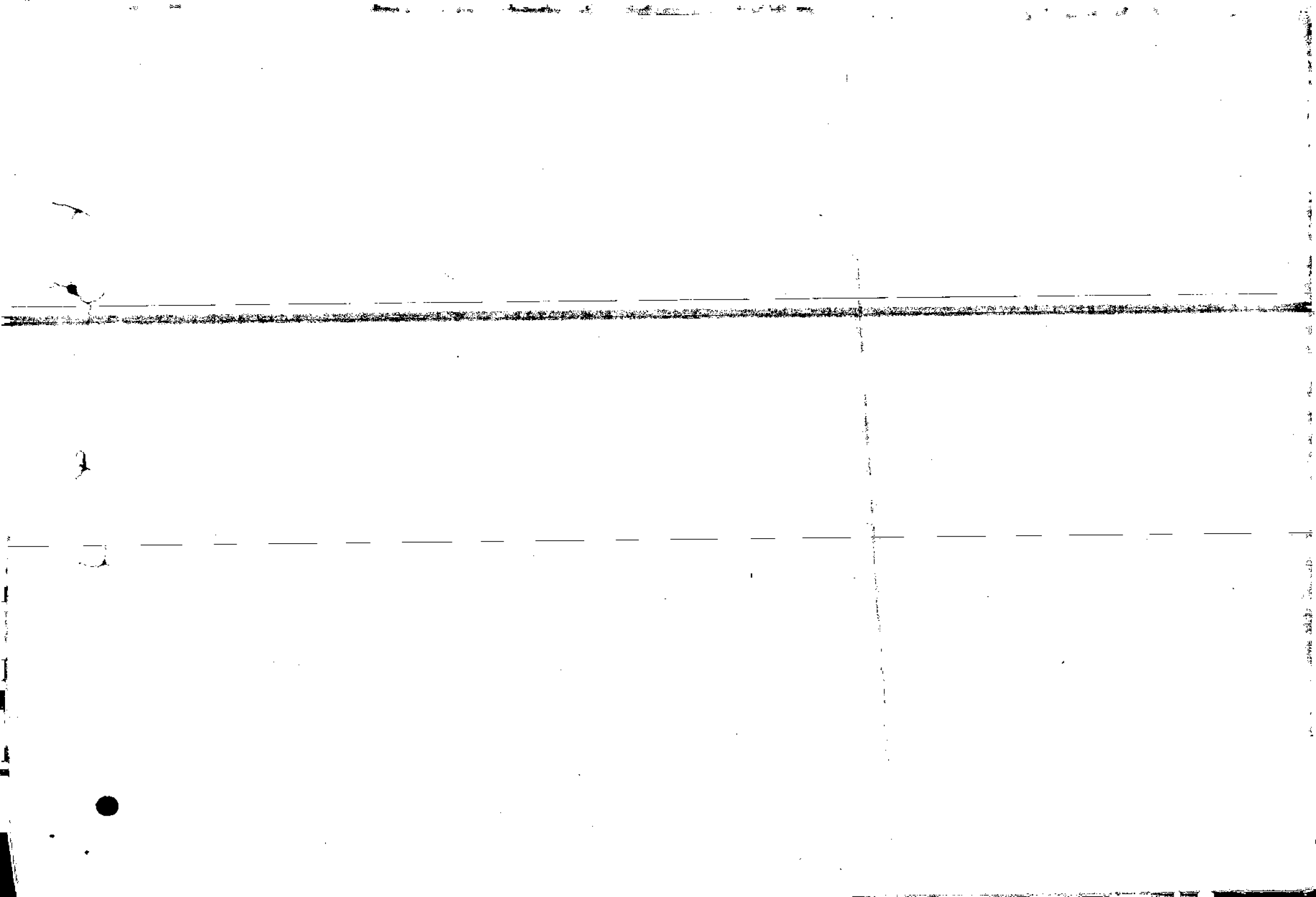

G.S.R. 672. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating method recruitment in Group 'C' posts in the Customs Department, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement:- (1) These rules may be called the Customs Department (Group 'C') Recruitment Rules, 1979. (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. Application:- These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column 2 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
3. Number of posts, classification and scales of pay:- The number of the said posts, their classification and the scales of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in column 3 to 5 of the said Schedule.
4. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualification etc.:- The method of recruitment to the said posts, age limit, qualifications and other matters connected therewith shall be as specified in column 6 to 14 of the Schedule aforesaid. Provided that the upper age limit proscribed may be relaxed in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued from time to time by the Central Government.

Disqualifications :- No person —

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having spouse living, or
- (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person

shall be eligible for appointment to any of the said posts ;
provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person, from the operation of this rules.

6. Power to relax - Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons or post

7. Special provisions regarding Custom House (1) Each Custom House shall have its own separate cadre unless otherwise so ordered by the Central Board of Excise and Customs. (2) Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-rule (1) the Central Board of Excise and Customs may :-

(a) If it considers it necessary or expedient in the public interest so to do and subject to such conditions as it may specify having regard to the circumstances of the case and for reasons to be recorded in writing ; order any post in the Customs Department to be filled by transfer from persons holding the same comparable post but belonging to the cadre of another Department or office under the Central Board of Excise and Customs ; and

(b) If it considers it necessary or expedient on compassionate grounds, order that a post in the Customs Department which is to be filled by direct recruitment under these rules, should be filled by transfer or deputation of a person holding a comparable higher post from any other Department or office under the Central Board of Excise and Customs subject to such conditions as it may specify having regard to the circumstances of the case.

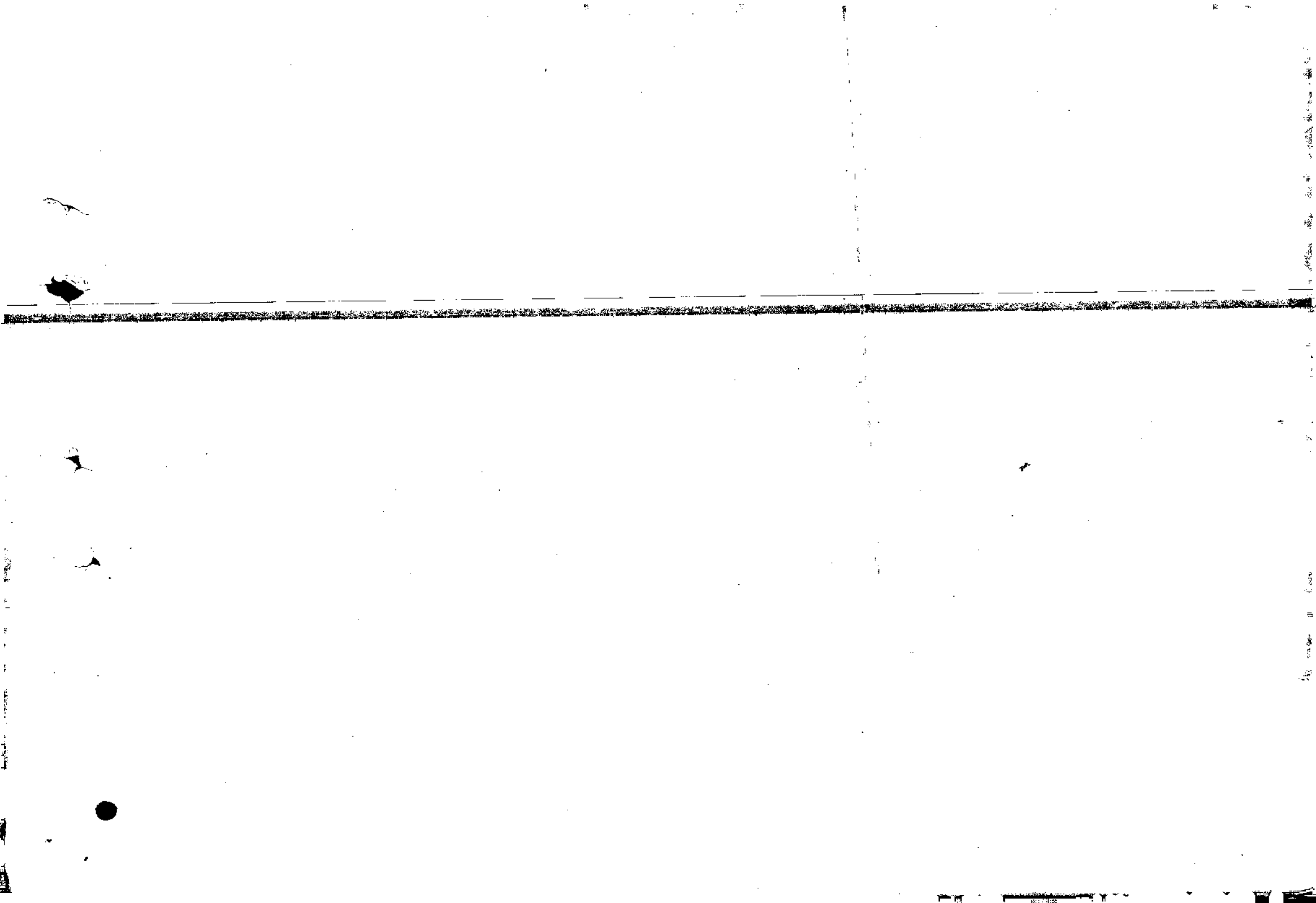
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8. Saving - Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

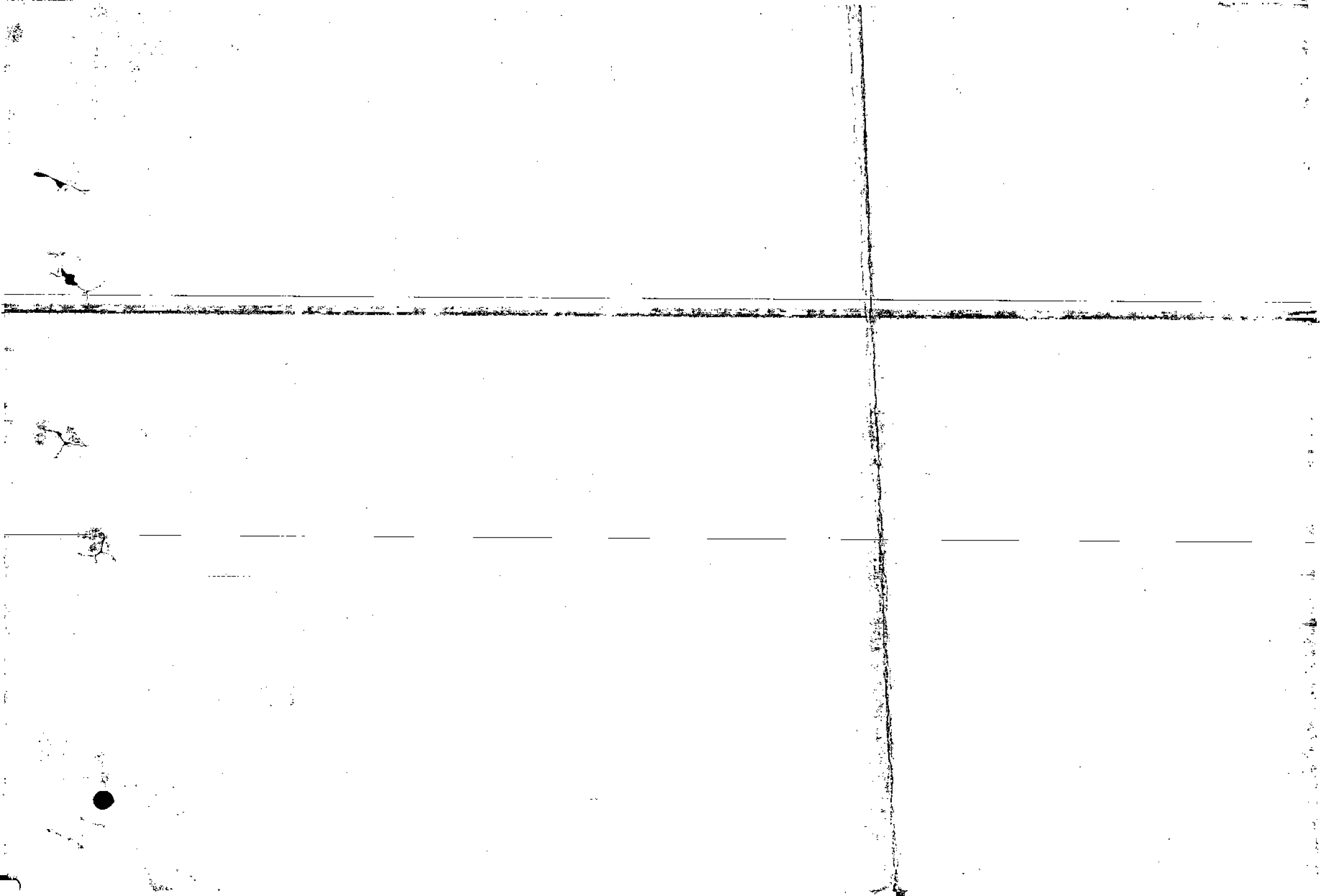

G.S.R. 742 In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to group C posts in the Central Excise and Land Customs Department, namely:-

1 Short title and commencement - (1) These rules may be called the Central Excise and Land Customs Department Group C posts Recruitment Rules, 1979.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2 Application- These rules shall apply to the posts as specified in Column 2 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3 Number of posts, classification and scale of pay - The number of the said posts, their classification and the scales of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 3 to 5 of the said Schedule.

4 Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications etc. - The method of recruitment to the said posts, age limit, qualifications and other matters connected therewith shall be as specified in columns 6 to 14 of the Schedule aforesaid.

Provided that the upper age limit prescribed may be relaxed in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued from time to time by the Central Government.

5 (1) Special provisions regarding Collectorates - Each Collectorate shall have its own separate cadre unless otherwise prescribed by the Central Board of Excise and Customs.

(2) Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-rule (1) the Central Board of Excise and Customs may -

- (a) If it considers to be necessary or expedient in the public interest so to do, and subject to such conditions as it may specify, having regard to the circumstances of the case and for reason to be recorded in writing, orders, any post in one Collectorate of Central Excise and Land Customs to be filled by transfer from persons holding the same or comparable post but belonging to the cadre of another Central Excise Collectorate or Department or office under the Central Board of Excise and Customs: or of the Office of the Central Board of Excise and Customs and
- (b) If it considers to be necessary or expedient on compassionate grounds order that a post in Collectorate of Central Excise and Land Customs which is to be filled by direct recruitment under these rules, should be filled by transfer or designation of a person holding the same or comparable or higher post from any other Collectorate of Central Excise or any Department or Office under the Central Board of Excise and Customs or Office of the Central Board of Excise and Customs subject to such conditions as it may specify having regard to the circumstances of the case.

6. Disqualifications - No person**

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living or

- (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person shall be eligible for appointment to any of the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

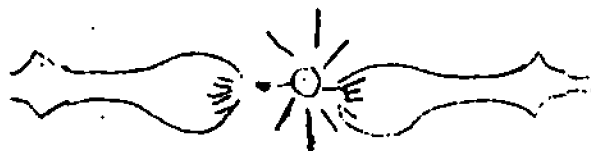
7. Power to relax - Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, and for reasons to be recorded in writing relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.*

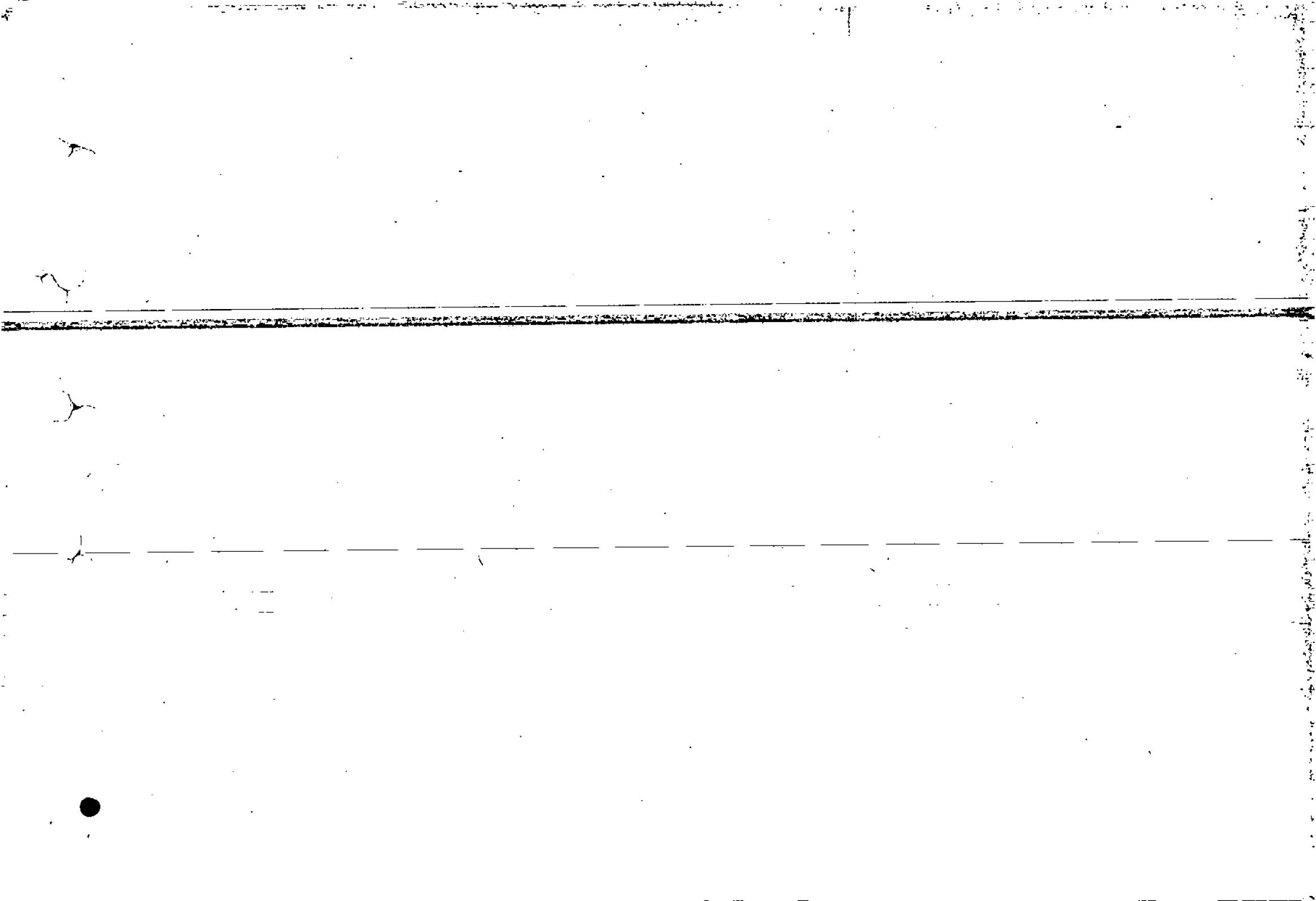
8. 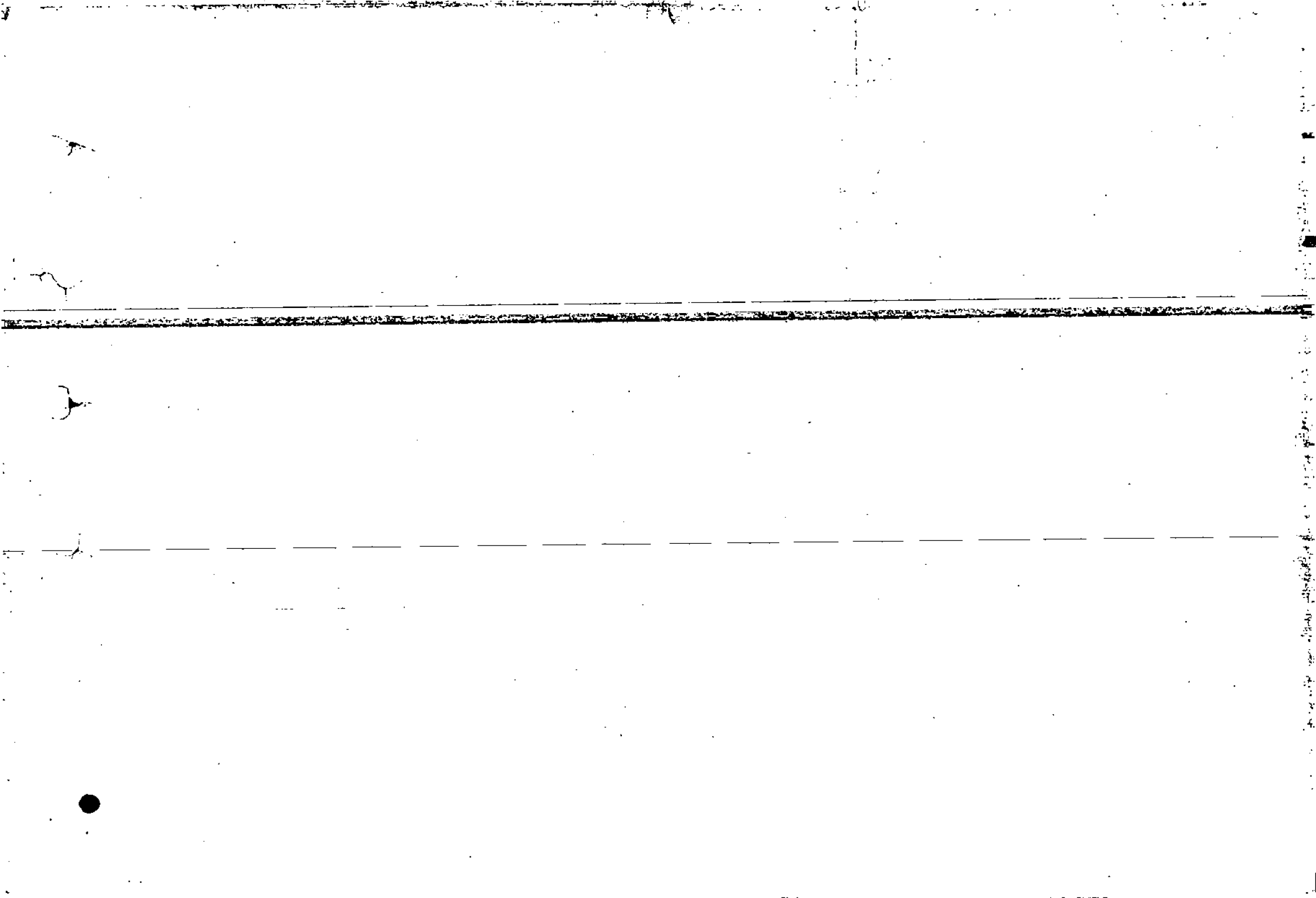

- (ii) Physical Tests:
 Walking - 1600 meters in 15 minutes.
 Cycling - 8 Kms. in 30 minutes.

For Female candidates

- (i) Physical Standards (minimum)
 Height - 152 cms.
 Weight - 48 Kgs.

{ Height relaxable by 2.5 cms. and weight by 2 Kgs. for Gorkhas Garwalies, Assamese and members of the Scheduled Tribes.

- (ii) Physical Tests:
 Walking - 1 Km. in 20 minutes
 Cycling - 3 Kms. in 25 minutes.

(The above physical standards/tests shall also be applicable for filling up the posts by promotion, if any)".

Group 'C' Departmental Promotion Committee:

(I) Single Collectorate, i.e., Collectorates having no common cadre -

- (1) The senior-most Additional Collector at Headquarters office - Chairman.
- (2) The Deputy Collector Headquarters, failing which any other senior-most Deputy Collector (at Headquarters) available at the time of Departmental Promotion Committee meeting - Member.
- (3) Assistant Commissioner of Income-Tax - Member.
- (4) Where none of the members at Serial No.1 to 3 above belongs to the Scheduled Castes or the Scheduled Tribes a Group 'A' Officer from outside the Department belonging to the Scheduled Castes or the Scheduled Tribes, shall also associate as a member of Departmental Promotion Committee.

(II) Composite Collectorates, i.e. two or more Collectorates having common cadre -

- (1) The senior-most Additional Collector from each of the Collectorates (the senior-most officer among them would be the Chairman).
- (2) The Deputy Collector Headquarters of the cadre controlling Collectorate, failing which any other senior most Deputy Collector (Headquarters) available at the time of Departmental Promotion Committee meeting- Member.
- (3) Assistant Commissioner of Income- tax - Member.
- (4) Where none of the members at serial No.1 to 3 above belongs to the Scheduled Tribes, a Group 'A' officer from outside the Department belonging to the Scheduled Caste or Scheduled Tribes, shall also associate as a member of Departmental Promotion Committee.
