NOTIFICATION

G.S.R. _____ In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules for regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Superintendent of Central Excise in the Collectorates of Central Excise, namely :-

1. **SHORT TITLE AND COMMENCEMENT :-**

(1) These rules may be called the Superintendents of Central Excise Recruitment Rules, 1986.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their Publication in the Official Gazette.

2. **NUMBER OF POST, CLASSIFICATION AND SCALE OF PAY :-**

The number of the said post, its classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. **METHOD OF RECRUITMENT, AGE LIMIT AND OTHER QUALIFICATIONS :-**

The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in column 5 to 14 of the said Schedule.

4. **PERSONS HOLDING POST AT THE COMMENCEMENT OF THE RULES :-**

Persons holding the post of Superintendent of Central Excise on a regular basis at the commencement of these rules shall be deemed to have been appointed at the initial constitution to that post in the cadre for which the said post is allocated.

5. **DISQUALIFICATIONS: - No person. -**

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or
- (b) who having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post :

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Provided that the Central Government may, if Satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the Personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. POWER TO RELAX :- Where the Central Government is of opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

7. SAVING :- Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation in the age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the candidates belonging to the Schedule Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and other special categories in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

12. **Promotion** Inspector of Central Excise (ordinary Grade) with 8 years regular service in the grade, if any, rendered in the grade of Inspectors (Senior Grade).
13. **Group 'B' Departmental Promotion Committee**
- (1) Jurisdictional Principal Collector of Customs or Central Excise or in his absence Director General of Inspection (Customs and Central Excise)- Chairman.
 - (2) Collector concerned – Member
 - (3) Any other Collector/Director under the Central Board of Excise and Customs where the cadre comprises of one Collectorate only—Member.
 - (4) Deputy Collector (Personal and Establishment) of the Cadre Controlling Collectorate – Member.
14. Consultation with Union Public Service Commission is necessary while making direct recruitment.

Departmental Promotion Committee for confirmation and crossing of efficiency Bar.

(1) Collector concerned with the cadre- Senior most Collector will be Chairman of Departmental Promotion Committee

(2) Any other Collector at the same station or if there is no such Collector, the Collector of neighboring Collectorate, where cadre comprised of one Collectorate only.

(3) Deputy Collector of the Cadre controlling Collectorate.

Note:- The proceeding of the Departmental Promotion Committee relating to confirmation in the case of Superintendents of Central excise directly recruited shall be sent to the Commission for approval. If however, these are not approved by the Commission, a fresh meeting of the Departmental Promotion Committee to be presided over by the Chairman or Member of the Committee shall be held.

G.S.R. 65.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules to amend the Superintendents of Central Excise Recruitment Rules, 1986, namely: -

1. (i) These rules may be called the Superintendents of Central Excise Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 2018.
(ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. In the Superintendents of Central Excise Recruitment Rules, 1986, -
(I) for rule 2, the following rule shall be substituted, namely: -

“2. Number of post, classification and Level in the Pay Matrix.—The number of the said post, its classification and the Level in the Pay Matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.”;

(II) in the Schedule, -

(a) in column (4), -

(i) for the column heading, the following column heading shall be substituted, namely:-

“Level in the Pay Matrix”;

(ii) for the entry, the following entry shall be substituted, namely: -

“Level 8 in the Pay Matrix (Rs. 47600-151100)”;

(b) in column (12), for the entry, the following entry shall be substituted, namely: -

“Inspector of Central Excise in Level 7 in the Pay Matrix (Rs. 44900-142400) with 8 years regular service in the grade.”
