G.S.R. 591.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Directorate of Inspection (Customs and Central Excise) (Class III and Class IV posts) Recruitment Rules, 1975 except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to Group 'C' and Group 'D' posts in the Directorate General of Inspection (Customs and Central Excise) namely:—

1. Short title and commencement.—(1) These rules may be called the Directorate General of Inspection (Customs and Central Excise) (Group 'C' and Group 'D' posts) Recruitment Rules, 1988.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Application.—These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column 2 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Number of posts, classification and scale of pay.—The number of the said posts, their classification and the scales of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 3 to 5 of the said Schedule.

4. Method of recruitment, age limit, other qualifications etc.—The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in columns 6 to 15 of the Schedule aforesaid.

5. Disqualifications.—No person, —

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall not be eligible for appointment to any of the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any such person from the operation of this rule.

6. Power to relax.—Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect of any class or category of person.

7. Saving.—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes the Scheduled Tribes, ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

Promotion :

(i) Senior Tax Assistants with three years regular service in the grade in pay Band Rs. 93000-34800/-.

Note: Where juniors who have completed their qualifying or eligibility service are being considered for promotion, their seniors would also be considered provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying or eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying or eligibility service or two years, whichever is less, and have successfully completed their probation Period for Promotion to the next higher grade along with their juniors who have already completed such qualifying or eligibility service.

(ii) Promotion to the grade of Deputy Office Superintendent shall be made Zone-wise
