NOTIFICATION

G.S.R. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to certain class II posts, in the Directorate of Revenue Intelligence in the Department of Personnel and Administrative Reforms, namely:-

SHORT TITLE AND COMMENCEMENT:

- (1) These rules may be called the Directorate of Revenue Intelligence (Class II Gazetted posts) Recruitment Rules, 1975.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

NUMBER OF POSTS, CLASSIFICATION AND SCALE OF PAY:

The number of said posts, their classification and the scales of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed hereto.

METHOD OF RECRUITMENT, AGE LIMIT AND OTHER QUALIFICATIONS ETC:

The method of recruitment to the said posts, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in columns 5 to 13 of the said Schedule.

DISQUALIFICATIONS:

No person -

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or
- (b) who having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any persons shall be eligible for appointment to any of the said posts.

to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. POWER TO RELAX: Where the Central Government is of opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may be order, for orders to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules, in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, with respect to any class or category of persons or posts.

6. SAVINGS:- Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
