

G.S.R. 1434 - In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to Group 'A' posts in the Directorate of Preventive Operations (communication Wing) Department of Revenue and Banking (Revenue Wing) namely:-

1. Short title and commencement - (1) These rules may be called the Directorate of Preventive Operations (communication Wing) (Group 'A' posts) Recruitment Rules, 1976. (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the official Gazette.
2. Application - These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column 1 of the Schedule annexed to these Rules.
3. Number of posts Classification and Scales of pay - The number of posts, their Classification and the Scales of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in Column 2 to 4 of the said Schedule.
4. Method of Recruitment, age limit and other qualifications. The method of recruitment to the said posts, age limit qualification and other matters connected therewith, shall be as specified in Columns 5 to 13 of the Schedule aforesaid.
5. Disqualifications - No person,
 - (a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living or
 - (b) Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to any of the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied, that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. Power to relax - Where the Central Government is of opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order for reasons to be recorded in writing (and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission) relax any of the provisions of those rules with respect to any class or category of persons or any of the said posts.

7. Savings - Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations and concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribe and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
